TMI Services, based in Fort Worth, Texas, is one of the leading solutions providers for the convenience store and petroleum industry. TMI's retail application is in use at nearly 5,000 convenience stores in the United States. The application was resold until recently by Oklahoma City-based Factor as their StoreTrak™ product.

The TMI Services acquisition marks FireStream's third acquisition since the company began in 2001. In 2002, FireStream acquired Advantage Energy Systems, based in Corvallis, Ore., a provider of computer automation solutions to Petroleum Marketers and C-Store operators. Earlier this year FireStream completed its second acquisition of Symbology Systems, Inc. Based in Newport Beach, Calif., Symbology Systems provides automated fuel delivery and management systems for both fleet fueling and commercial deliveries.

FireStream's Ascend software is an integrated back-office accounting, order and inventory management system. The TMI acquisition accelerates FireStream's goal of migrating its existing retail solution to match its wholesale solution built on MicroSoft's powerful SQL Server platform.

FireStream has already begun integrating the two companies' development and support operations to ensure a smooth transition and immediate value for FireStream retail customers and companies that are currently using the TMI application branded as Factor Store Trak™. George Cooper, founder of TMI Services, will continue on as FireStream's Retail Product Manager.

FireStream retail customers have been interested in pricebook, lottery tracking and workforce management enhancements and the TMI product brings those capabilities immediately.
